AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ORO VALLEY, ARIZONA, FOR A TRANSLATIONAL ZONING FROM PIMA COUNTY RURAL HOMESTEAD (RH) TO ORO VALLEY R1-144 (SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL) ZONING DISTRICT FOR A 10-ACRE ANNEXED AREA KNOWN AS ANNEXATION AREA "O", LOCATED AT 14260 N. HAWK CANYON TRAIL, SOUTH OF STONE CANYON AND NORTH OF LA CHOLLA AIRPARK; PARCELS 219-15-003A AND 219-15-003B

WHEREAS, the Town of Oro Valley is a political subdivision of the State of Arizona vested with all associated rights, privileges and benefits and is entitled to the immunities and exemptions granted municipalities and political subdivisions under the Constitution and laws of the State of Arizona and the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Oro Valley, being the applicant, requests approval of a translational zoning from Pima County Rural Homestead (RH) to Oro Valley R1-144 (single family residential) zone for Annexation Area "O", located at 14260 N. Hawk Canyon Trail, south of Stone Canyon and north of La Cholla Airpark, Parcels 219-15-003A and 219-15-003B; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission reviewed said translational zoning request at a duly noticed Public Hearing on February 1, 2011 in according with State statutes, and unanimously recommended approval to the Town Council; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has duly considered the translational zoning request and the Planning and Zoning Commission's recommendation at a Public Hearing and finds that granting the requested translational zoning, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference, it is consistent with the Town's General Plan and other Town ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and the Council of the Town of Oro Valley, Arizona, that:

- SECTION 1. The translational zoning for Annexation Area "O", attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference, located at 14260 N. Hawk Canyon Trail, south of Stone Canyon and north of La Cholla Airpark, Parcels 219-15-003A and 219-15-003B is granted pursuant to A.R.S. Section 9-471(L) of the Arizona Revised Statutes and that all applicable standards of the Oro Valley Zoning Code Revised shall apply to said property.
- **SECTION 2.** All Oro Valley ordinances, resolutions or motions and parts of ordinances, resolutions or motions of the Council in conflict with the provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3 If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ORO VALLEY, ARIZONA, EXTENDING AND INCREASING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF ORO VALLEY, ARIZONA, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, TITLE 9, CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE 7, AND AMENDMENTS THERETO, $\mathbf{B}\mathbf{Y}$ ANNEXING THERETO CERTAIN TERRITORY CONTIGUOUS TO THE EXISTING TOWN LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF ORO VALLEY, ARIZONA (10)ACRES, ANNEXATION AREA O)

WHEREAS, a petition in writing, accompanied by a map or plat of Annexation Area O, attached hereto as Exhibits "A" and "B", having been filed and presented to the Mayor and Council of the Town of Oro Valley, Arizona, signed by the owners of more than one-half in value of the real and personal property and more than one-half of the persons owning real and personal property as would be subject to taxation by the Town of Oro Valley, Arizona in the event of amexation within Amexation Area O as shown by the last assessment of said property, which said territory is contiguous to the Town of Oro Valley, Arizona, asking that Annexation Area O more particularly described in Exhibits "A" and "B" be annexed to the Town of Oro Valley, Arizona, extending and increasing the corporate limits of the Town of Oro Valley; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Oro Valley, Arizona, desire to comply with said petition, extending and increasing the corporate limits of the Town of Oro Valley to include Annexation Area O; and

WHEREAS, the said petition sets forth a true and correct description of all the exterior boundaries of the entire area proposed to be annexed to the Town of Oro Valley, and had attached thereto at all times an accurate map of the territory desired to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, no alterations increasing or reducing the territory sought to be annexed have been made after the said petition had been signed by any owner of real and personal property in such territory; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of ARS 9-471, and amendments thereto, have been fully observed; and

WHEREAS, proper and sufficient certification and proof of the foregoing facts are now on file in the Office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Oro Valley, Arizona, together with a true and correct copy of the original petition referred to herein, which is on file in the Office of the County Recorder of Pima County, Arizona.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Oro Valley, Arizona, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory be, and the same hereby is, annexed to the Town of Oro Valley, Arizona, and that the present corporate limits be, and the same hereby are, extended and increased to include the following described territory contiguous to the present Oro Valley limits, to wit as fully described in Exhibits "A" and "B", attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference including county/state lands.

SECTION 2. That a copy of this Ordinance, together with an accurate map of the territory hereby annexed to the Town of Oro Valley, Arizona, certified by the Mayor of said Town of Oro Valley, be forthwith filed and recorded in the Office of the County Recorder of Pima County, Arizona.

SECTION 3. All Oro Valley Ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.



